FACIAL BALANCE

KEY EMPHASIS

- Orthopedic correction of skeletal imbalances
- Narrow upper/lower jaws (width)
- Setback upper/lower jaws (forward/back)
- Achieving a full, straight profile with sufficient skeletal support for soft tissues
- Ensuring balanced facial proportions across all facial thirds

- Enhances beauty and harmony, especially when smiling, through facial balance
- Supports anti-aging of soft tissues by maintaining proper facial balance and skeletal support
- Improves airway function by correcting skeletal imbalances



LIP BALANCE + PROPER TOOTH POSITION

KEY EMPHASIS

- Ensuring 100% front tooth display with 1-2mm of gum show
- Ideal tooth angle for proper lip position, avoiding excessive leaning backward or forward
- Maintaining adequate lip volume and support

- Enhances beauty and harmony, especially when smiling, through facial balance
- Supports anti-aging of soft tissues by maintaining proper facial balance and skeletal support
- Improves airway function by correcting skeletal imbalances



ALIGNMENT + SMILE ARCH

KEY EMPHASIS

- · Straight teeth with all spaces closed
- Upper front teeth edges following the lower lip line
- Seamless progression of each tooth from front to back
- Centered upper and lower midlines on the face


- Restored confidence in your smile through optimal tooth alignment
- Radiant and energetic smile, devoid of distractions
- Enhanced oral hygiene and reduced risk of gum disease













BROAD, BRIGHT SMILES Damon Arch form key to Orthobar Smiles

KEY EMPHASIS

- · Wide and broad smile
- · Teeth and smile fill the entire corners of mouth
- · Smile flows harmoniously from one side to the other

- · Anti-aging benefits as a broad smile provides better support to the cheeks and lips
- · Enhanced attractiveness





FUNCTIONAL OCCLUSION

KEY EMPHASIS

- Upper teeth overlap lower teeth proportionally
- Ideal overbite achieved
- All teeth make contact and support each other

- Prevents excessive wear, chipping, or fractures of the teeth
- Improves chewing efficiency
- Reduces the risk of jaw pain and discomfort








AESTHETIC TOOTH SHAPE + CONTOUR

Hard Tissue Contouring

KEY EMPHASIS

- Golden proportions: Emulating natural beauty principles
- Teeth with a natural veneer-like appearance
- · Ideal height-to-width ratios

- Achieves a youthful, harmonious, and symmetrical smile
- Ensures symmetrical and ideal light reflection for picture-perfect selfies





GUM DISPLAY + CONTOURS

Soft Tissue Contouring

KEY EMPHASIS

- · Wide and broad smile
- Teeth and smile fill the entire corners of mouth
- Smile flows harmoniously from one side to the other

- Anti-aging benefits as a broad smile provides better support to the cheeks and lips
- · Enhanced attractiveness





BONUS

INTERDISCIPLINARY ORTHODONTICS

KEY EMPHASIS

- · Tooth size and harmony
- · Tooth color and shape
- Level gingival line architecture

- Proper teeth in alignment lead to less tooth preparation
- Unveiling a beautiful, natural tooth appearance by reducing excess gum tissue
